Mission Statement of PLC Pet Power

*"To enhance communications & relationships between generations
And with those in facilities or in group settings."*

As a certified Parkville Living Center Pet Power Volunteer, I understand and agree:

- To comply with training, documentation, certification, and re certification requirements; this includes providing all required paperwork two weeks before temperament testing.
- To make 6 or more visits annually and share visit reports with coordinator
- To ensure my program pet is clean, in good health & free of any contagious conditions when volunteering.
- To control my pet at all times during the programs.
- To provide my own transportation and pay my own expenses incurred as part of official volunteer activities. Expenses may be tax deductible with proper documentation.
- To refrain from using alcohol or illegal drugs while participating in volunteer activities, volunteering while intoxicated, or possessing any weapons during volunteer activities.
- To use the title of Parkville Living Center Pet Power Volunteer to signify a trained and caring individual and appropriate Pet Partner.
- To not take my pet to nursing home, group settings or for any official volunteer service if animal has given signs of inappropriate behavior, personality, or actions of any kind that may endanger others or me.
- To not substitute or take any animal that has not been approved the Pet Power program veterinarian.

(Volunteers are Recognized as Parkville Living Center Pet Power volunteers if they:

- Participate in orientation, provide up to date pet health form, & signed contract and pet is approved at initial and annual temperament testing

Make 6 or more visits annually to cooperating sites or arrange for other facility to sign site waiver.
Share reports of visits; include positive effects as well as issues.

I further understand that Parkville Living Center will:

- Disseminate information and program updates to all program volunteers, without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability, or sexual orientation
- Support the Parkville Living Center Pet Power Program & coordinate publicity and promotion
- Provide training, oversight, and direction to volunteers
- Recruit group facilities that want PLC Pet Power visits and maintain site waivers for all
- Send update contacts for cooperating sites to all PPP volunteers on timely basis
- Recruit and coordinate temperament testing with volunteer veterinarians
- Support communications and supplies



Parkville Living Center Pet Power Agreement



I have read and understand this Pet Power Volunteer contract and further agree to abide by the conditions of this contract until it is revoked or revised.

Assumption of Risk. I fully understand that participating in the program may not only involve risk of injury or death, economic loss, property damage or loss that may result from my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also from the actions, inactions, or negligence of others and/or the condition of the property, and I voluntarily agree to assume this risk.

Covenant Not to Sue. I, my personal and legal representatives, heirs, successors and next of kin will not make any claim against Parkville Living Center, Parkville Presbyterian Church, or any of their present or former officers, members, managers, employees, volunteers, guests, sponsors, participating vendors, attorneys, insurers, and representatives (collectively, "PLC"), for injury, damage, death, or any other loss arising from or related to participating in the PLC Pet Power Program.

Release and Indemnification. Except to the extent directly and solely caused by PLC, I, my personal and legal representatives, heirs, successors and next of kin shall forever release, waive, discharge, relinquish and indemnify PLC from any and all actions, causes of action, claims, charges, demands, losses, damages, costs, attorney's fees, judgments, liens, indebtedness and liabilities of every kind and character, whether known or unknown, including foreseen or unforeseen bodily injury and personal injuries and property damage that may be sustained by me or any other person in any way connected to, related to, or arising out of my participation in the PLC Pet Power Program.

Personal Information. I also agree to allow my name & contact information to be listed and shared only with PLC Pet Power volunteers and with cooperating sites/agencies.

Use of Image. I authorize PLC to take pictures and sound recordings of my family/myself and use the same in any form for its purposes and consent that the pictures and recordings may be copied, published, telecast or broadcast for such purposes together with descriptions and editorial statements.

I have carefully read the Parkville Living Center Pet Power Agreement (the "Agreement") and fully understand its contents. I am aware that I have given up substantial rights by signing the Agreement, and I am signing the Agreement voluntarily. I have no obligation to participate in the program or sign this Agreement, but I desire to do so. I certify that I am at least eighteen years of age.
