“German Pink”

Indeterminate

Heirloom tomato that grows up to 6 feet tall. Produces 1-2 pound reddish-pink fruits with few seeds. Excellent slicing or canning tomato that keeps its flavor during processing. Provide support with stakes, cages, or trellises, and water deeply at the base to encourage healthy growth.

Detailed Growing Guide:

In-Ground Care:

- Support the plants with stakes, cages, or trellises to prevent them from toppling over with the weight of the fruit.
- Water the plants deeply and regularly, especially during the flowering and fruiting stages.
- Water at the base of the plant to avoid wetting the leaves, which can promote fungal diseases. Mulch deeply to avoid soil splashing onto leaves. Avoid irregular watering to reduce cracking.
- Consider mulching around the plants to help retain moisture and suppress weeds.
- Fertilize with a liquid fertilizer every 2 weeks or as needed.

Harvesting:
