

Tomato

Washington Cherry

Determinate

First-early determinate red cherry tomato.

High-yielding, compact plants. Globe-shaped, 20–25 gm. fruits have a deep-red color. Thick-walled, meaty, and flavorful, with good keeping quality on or off the vine. Widely adapted. Developed by Washington State University. Determinate.

While not explicitly listed with resistance to specific diseases, it is generally understood to be more resistant to cracking and other issues that can affect cherry tomatoes, particularly in cooler, wetter conditions.
