

Zinnia

“Zindarella Peach”

2–2 1/2" fully double, semidouble, and approximately 20% single flowers. Unique salmon color with cream-to-rose petals and a distinct dark eye. Cut-and-come-again flower, yielding multiple cuts over the season. Annual. Practice regular deadheading to encourage continuous blooming. Staking is usually not required for this variety.

Detailed Growing Guide:

- **Space** plants 9-12 inches apart

Watering and Fertilizing:

- **Watering:** Water deeply but infrequently to encourage a robust root system.
- **Fertilizing:** Use a balanced NPK fertilizer every 4-6 weeks during the growing season.

4. Care and Maintenance:

- **Deadheading:** Regularly remove spent flowers (deadhead) to promote continuous blooming and fuller plants.
- **Pruning:** Trim back any leggy growth to encourage a bushier appearance.
- **Pinching:** Pinch back young plants when they are 8-12 inches tall to encourage branching.
- **Support:** Consider staking or netting for taller varieties.

5. Harvesting:

- **Harvesting:** Harvest flowers when the stem is stiff and the flower is fully open.
- **Vase Life:** Stiff stems have a vase life of 7+ days.
